

1 DELEGATE STORM: Just in my handwriting.

2 THE CHAIRMAN: This is an entire substitution
3 for the section?

4 DELEGATE STORM: This combines the good elements
5 of 24 ---

6 THE CHAIRMAN: The language you intended is
7 a substitution for the entire amendment 24?

8 DELEGATE STORM: Yes, sir, and I am using
9 practically the same words as in 24, but just a little
10 change.

11 I will repeat it so that it is very clear. I
12 think this is important, and I think this will be very
13 clear to you:

14 "All public records shall be open for inspection
15 unless otherwise provided by law, and to the extent and
16 in the manner provided by law, all governmental proceedings
17 and meetings shall be open to the public."

18 THE CHAIRMAN: The Chair suggests it is very
19 difficult to carry it in mind.
