2 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: I object.

3 THE CHAIRMAN : Objections are heard, Delegate
4 Storm.

5 The question now rises on adoption of amendment 24.
6 The Clerk will ring the quorum bell.

8 24. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the amendment. A
9 vote No is a vote against.
