3 Under those circumstances, would you be content
4 to present your amendment at that time?

5 DELEGATE HARDWICKE: Mr. Chairman, I am somewhat
6 tempted to withdraw it.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: You don't have to present it. You
8 have the opportunity to present it at that time.

9 DELEGATE HARDWICKE: Very well.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: That being the situation ---

11 For what purpose does Delegate Boileau rise?

12 DELEGATE BOILEAU: A parliamentary inquiry.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: State your inquiry.

14 DELEGATE BOILEAU: By keeping open three sections
15 in R&P-2, does this allow additional sections such as you
16 noted in the case of Delegate Hardwicke to be added?

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Only if they were germane to the
18 portions that are still under consideration, in the same
19 way that any new section is to be added to recommendation
20 R&P-2 would have to be germane to that recommendation.

21 In other words, if they were germane to the subject
