

1 Delegate Johnson said. He said we might be accused by the  
2 people of not providing for removal of civil cases.

3 It is my understanding the amendment was  
4 passed 73 to 40, Amendment 13-B, which reads "Shall the  
5 Court of Appeals, by rule, or the General Assembly by  
6 law, shall provide for the right of removal of civil  
7 cases in the trial courts."

8 THE CHAIRMAN: That Amendment 13-B was adopted  
9 as a substitute for amendment 13 by a vote of 73 to 40  
10 but after the amendment as substituted was put to a vote  
11 on adoption, it was rejected by a vote of 44 to 80, so  
12 that the entire section was finally deleted.

13 Delegate Beatrice Miller, will you state  
14 your question.

15 DELEGATE BEATRICE MILLER: Yes, Mr. Chairman.  
16 I listened as hard as I could for the last two days but  
17 I am very confused. I don't know what all cases in equity  
18 means; I don't know what all cases that exceed the  
19 jurisdictional amount -- I don't know how much the  
20 jurisdictional amount is. I don't know what the effect of  
21 this amendment would be and I am unable to vote on it.
