2 within a reasonable time, and will be up to the Court of
3 Appeals or the General Assembly to prescribe what is a
4 reasonable time.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: This eliminates all of the
6 abuses which we have under the present system.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case, do you desire
8 to speak in favor or in opposition to amendment 25-A?

9 DELEGATE CASE: Mr. Chairman, I wanted to
10 ask the sponsor of 25-A a question.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Clagett, do you yield
12 to a question?

13 DELEGATE CLAGETT: Yes, sir, I yield.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

15 DELEGATE CASE: Why have you seen fit to
16 eliminate from this amendment cases in equity, and at the
17 same time you do not eliminate cases at law which are
18 tried without a jury?

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Clagett.

20 DELEGATE CLAGETT: There can be instances
21 where, notwithstanding the fact that the case is to be
