6 DELEGATE CASE: A point of order, Mr. Chairman.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: State the point.

8 DELEGATE CASE: I rise now to state the point
9 so the Chair can be thinking about it while this amendment
10 comes before us.

11 As I understand Delegate Storm's explanation
12 of it, it is an attempt at combination of Amendment
13 24 and 24-A. He is re-arranging both and putting them
14 together in a single amendment.

15 My point is we have had discussion on both these
16 sections, or both of these proposed amendments and I would
17 ask the Chair to rule whether or not the amendment is
18 proper, particularly in view of the ruling which the
19 Chair gave earlier this morning about the welfare state
20 amendment.
