5 DELEGATE CLARK: Delegate Wheatley.

6 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: When we use "law" throughout,
7 we had no idea what the various ramifications and delinea-
8 tions would be. We had used the law to refer to the
9 broadest concept. We certainly refer in this instance to
10 the concepts that would be in local as well as in the regu-
11 lations which would be of a state-wide nature. We are
12 changing nothing which is existing. We are merely reaffirm-
13 ing it. So if there was a local charter or whatever you
14 might call it, I don't know what it will be ultimately, I
15 assume it would be the charter, we would certainly want the
16 local subdivision to be able to control its local higher
17 educational institutions as well as its primary institu-
18 tions.

21 "law" here to be synonymous with "general public law"?
