2 DELEGATE CLARK: Delegate Johnson.

3 DELEGATE JOHNSON: I was willing to accept
4 your language or the committee's language in Section 2 as
5 largely oratory language. But in your answer to Delegate
6 Schloeder you indicated you meant something quite specific
7 by it when you said it would be measured in the result and
8 not in the input. I find this a little inconsistent with
9 your committee recommendation Section 2 and I am wondering
10 if you could expand exactly what you meant in answer to
11 Delegate Schloeder's question and whether or not that is
12 in conflict with Committee Recommendation 1, Section 2.

13 DELEGATE CLARK: Delegate Wheatley, the time is
14 up but we will allow you to answer this question.

15 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: I would say your earlier
16 assumption is correct. That the results must be measured
17 in a somewhat nondefinable term and you can't do it in
18 dollars and cents. It is basically something that must
19 be left to legislative determination as to how much is
20 enough. I think the committee recommendation is again in
21 that nature and my answer would certainly be the same.
