3 rapidly changing field that we now deal with in public
4 life. A recent quote from the Washington Post stated,
5 "Ideas for reorganizing public education are being cata-
6 pulted into the public arena like fireworks."

7 We of the Minority believe that the State should
8 be able to avail itself of these new ideas and adopt
9 those that it feels can be helpful. We submit that under
10 the Majority proposal this would be well nigh impossible.

11 Now, I would like to turn to the specific
12 language that is used by the Majority. Please understand
13 that in addition to the unique fact that the Committee
14 Chairman is not presenting the Majority Report but has
15 joined the Minority, and it is a 7-7-1 situation, there
16 is another unique situation in respect to this report in
17 that we in the Minority recommend an entirely new substi-
18 tute section. Those are the two paragraphs that appear
19 on the Minority Report. Those sections will be offered
20 as the debate schedule on your desk will indicate, as
21 substitutions for the Majority Report.
