

1 adopted by this Constitutional Convention, the position
2 of the boards, of the State Board and the local boards
3 is absolutely unchanged. If these boards have ever been
4 threatened, and the Minority question that they ever have
5 been, the threat is not greater under the local government
6 article as it exists. This lengthy Section 5, one of the
7 ones that the Majority appears to be pressing seriously
8 here today, is as I said, virtually as long as all the
9 constitutional language in the existing Constitution.
10 About half the questions from the Floor to Delegate Wheat-
11 is ley indicated that its meaning/ extremely unclear.

12 The Minority goes much further than that. It
13 is not only unclear, it is unnecessary, and an amendment
14 to strike that entire section offering no substitute
15 language will be offered.

16 Chairman Moser of the Committee on Local Govern-
17 ment will speak during the controlled time and will re-
18 emphasize the fact that this is purely superfluous and
19 also basically incomprehensible.

20 Now, Sections 6, 7 and 8 deal with the emotional
21 subject of autonomy in higher education.
