3 Minority Spokesman? Delegate Pullen.

4 DELEGATE PULLEN: Mr. Chairman, you made quite
5 a point --

6 THE CHAIRMAN: May I interrupt a moment, Dele-
7 gate Pullen? In view of the limited time for questions
8 and the number of delegates standing to ask questions,
9 the Chair will restrict each delegate to two questions.
