

1 I wish you would explain the difference as you
2 see them between the two terms.

3 DELEGATE LORD: I will certainly try to do that.

4 In coming up with the language, we read care-
5 fully the debates of the Commission on this subject, and
6 the report of Miscellaneous Provisions Committee, when it
7 reached the full Convention, had the language, the
8 General Assembly shall provide by law.

9 On a motion, the word State was substituted,
10 and this motion carried 20 votes to 1 vote; and the basis,
