3 coin, if I could briefly finish, the local boards are
4 given only the power to manage, whereas actually under
5 Article 77 as it is written now, they have the power of
6 control.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Maurer.

8 DELEGATE MAURER: Delegate Lord, could you
9 please tell me whether the phrase, by law, indicates by
10 public general law, or by law which can vary from county
11 to county? That is line 7, 8.03, Public Education, the
12 State shall provide by law.

13 DELEGATE LORD: Delegate Maurer, it is the in-
14 tention of the Minority --

15 THE CHAIRMAN: The Chair is lost. Line 7 of
16 what, Delegate Maurer?

17 DELEGATE MAURER: I am sorry, sir, the Minority
18 Report which we are following.

19 DELEGATE LORD: The answer is that it is the
20 intention of the Minority clearly that this could be a
21 law that varies in force and effect from county to county.
