5 Does it mean that there is going to be a grad-
6 uate school for all as long as they want it? I can see
7 an enormous amount and number of legal problems. How
8 would it conflict with Poly programs, where things are
9 being tried. That is what I am talking about when I say
10 diversity, when we try something, when we want to, because
11 as someone pointed out today, if anything is happening
12 today, there are new ideas coming today in the field of
13 education, and we must be free to present these ideas.
14 We must be free to try these ideas. This amendment, it
15 seems to me, I think it tries, but in the name of helping
16 education, I think it reduces it, hurts it, and destroys
17 it.

18 One other point that I would like to make.
19 It is something, I think, we should get our perspective
20 back, when we think of putting in special types of re-
21 visions like this. I would be interested, of course, to
