

1 DELEGATE NEEDLE: I think that should be left
2 to the General Assembly, Delegate Wheatley. I think 90
3 or 120-day provision would be appropriate but I would
4 hesitate to write it into the constitution.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Wheatley.

6 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: We are presented with
7 this, as provided by law, is that correct?

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Needle.

9 DELEGATE NEEDLE: That's my intention.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Ready
11 for the question? The Clerk will ring the quorum bell.

12 The question arises on the adoption of Amendment
13 No. 3. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the amendment.
14 A vote No is a vote against. Cast your votes.

15 (Whereupon a roll call vote was taken.)

16 Has every delegate voted? Does any delegate
17 desire to change his vote? The Clerk will record the
18 vote.

19 There being 53 votes in the affirmative and
20 67 in the negative, the motion is lost, the amendment
21 is rejected.
