9 the committee rooms a copy of the calendar and agenda
10 for tomorrow.

11 Please keep in mind that the reason for this,
12 and the importance of it, is to enable you to see in
13 advance what is going to be up for consideration at the
14 next session so that you can be prepared for it, prepared
15 to discuss it if that is your desire; but also, and this
16 is very important, so that you will know what action the
17 Committee on Calendar and Agenda proposes to take for the next
18 day and not have to wait until the beginning of the ses-
19 sion to learn what it is.
