4 (The motion was duly seconded)

5 THE CHAIRMAN: All in favor signify by saying
6 Aye. Contrary No. The Ayes have it, and it is so ordered.

7 (Whereupon, at 12 o'clock noon, the Committee
8 of the Whole rose, and the Convention reconvened.)

9 (The mace was replaced by the Sergeant-at-Arms.)

10 THE PRESIDENT: The Convention will please come
11 to order.

12 On behalf of the Committee, the Chair reports
13 the Committee has under consideration LB-3, that it still
14 has it under consideration, and desires leave to sit again.

15 The matter for special order is the consideration
16 of the motion to reconsider the vote by which committee
17 recommendation GP-4, dealing with consumer protection,
18 was adopted on special reading.

19 Under the motion adopted yesterday, debate is
20 limited to a total of 20 minutes, ten minutes on each
21 side. Each speech is limited to 2 minutes.
