2 DELEGATE PENNIMAN: That is correct.

3 DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: I just wanted to make sure
4 that is the understanding.

5 Will you agree a first reading makes it look like
6 the right can be given for a specific election, but this is
7 not what you wanted to say, is this right?

8 THE PRESIDENT: What line are you directing
9 this to, Delegate Rybczynski?

10 DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: Line 39, sir -- "may be
11 permitted by law to vote in a municipal election".

12 The committee wants that to read that once
13 the right is granted by the municipal corporation that
14 the right will go on forever until changed by that
15 municipal corporation. Does this change that you have
16 made change the intent in any way?

17 DELEGATE PENNIMAN: No, it in no way changes
18 the intent.
