2 and by ordinance.

3 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Gullett.

4 DELEGATE GULLETT: I support Delegate White's
5 amendment, then.

6 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Koss.

7 DELEGATE KOSS: Mr. President, the only reason
8 that that second sentence was in there, and we are per-
9 fectly willing to be proved wrong, was that the
10 committee felt that the initial language, "Ownership of
11 an interest in property shall not be required as a condition
12 for holding any elective or appointive office of this
13 state or of any unit of local government", might be
14 interpreted to prohibit the requirement of bond.

15 If we can be assured that that was a misinter-
16 pretation, then we would have no objection.

17 THE PRESIDENT: I don't believe anybody can
18 give you that assurance, Delegate Koss.

19 DELEGATE KOSS: Well, Delegate Sherbow seemed
20 to make that implication.
