

1 A vote No is a vote against.

2 Cast your vote.

3 The Clerk will ring the quorum bell, please.

4 Cast your votes.

5 Delegate James Clark.

6 DELEGATE JAMES CLARK: I vote Aye.

7 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate James Clark votes Aye.

8 Have all delegates voted? Does any delegate
9 desire to change his vote?

10 The Clerk will record the vote.

11 There being 94 votes in the affirmative, and 14
12 in the negative, the motion is carried, and the amendment
13 is adopted.

14 Are there any other amendments to section 2.07?

15 Delegate Burdette.

16 DELEGATE BURDETTE: Mr. President, may I propound
17 a parliamentary inquiry which comes from the problem of
18 dealing with an amendment without seeing it in writing, and
19 I might say somewhat facetiously from the persuasiveness
20 of the President.
