3 Delegate Fox.

4 DELEGATE FOX: Mr. Chairman, I rise in opposition
5 to the amendment and to ask Delegate Marion if he would
6 accept a substitute amendment. There have been some
7 ten or fifteen amendments prepared to the present time.
8 One of them would end this --

9 THE CHAIRMAN: State your substitute and we
10 will find out if Delegate Marion will accept it.

11 DELEGATE FOX: The General Assembly may provide
12 by law for a militia. The Governor shall be its
13 commander-in-chief -- period.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Do I understand that your
15 substitute would be to strike out all of the committee
16 recommendation except the first two lines and the first
17 two words -- sorry -- Lines 8 and 9 and the first two
18 words of Line 10?

19 DELEGATE FOX: That is correct.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Marion, do you desire to
