

1 DELEGATE CHABOT: Could the delegate explain
2 to us in just what way on this point the committee
3 report differs from the language that appears in
4 Article 32 of our present Declaration of Rights?

5 DELEGATE E. J. CLARKE: I don't have that language
6 before me, Delegate Chabot. You mean Federal?

7 DELEGATE CHABOT: Our Declaration of
8 Rights.

9 DELEGATE E. J. CLARKE: I think it is just a
10 different verbiage, Delegate Chabot.

11 DELEGATE CHABOT: Same meaning.

12 DELEGATE E. J. CLARKE: Same meaning as I
13 read it, yes.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Delegate
15 Marion.

16 DELEGATE MARION: Mr. Chairman, if the
17 language of GP-1 in Line 20 is changed from "in" to
18 "of," I would urge that the amendment which is before
19 us make the same change in Line 4 so that the word
20 "in" reads instead of "of."
