2 DELEGATE SOLLINS: I have a question in another
3 area, Mr. Chairman.

4 THE PRESIDENT: All right.

5 DELEGATE SOLLINS: May a local law as you
6 describe it still be petitioned to referendum statewide
7 as provided in Section 2.10?

8 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Koss.

9 DELEGATE KOSS: How do you define "local law"?

10 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Sollins.

11 DELEGATE SOLLINS: As you have defined it, one
12 county.

13 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Koss.

14 DELEGATE KOSS: Theoretically, yes. Practically,
15 I am in doubt.
