and what we feel should be carried on up until May 14.

That is the duty we have under the mandate of the General Assembly to inform and disseminate information to the general public so they can make an intelligent and informed choice on May 14.

We are not to take a pro or con attitude on the issues, but merely to inform. We have had many meetings and advised on many policies. We hope that we have been helpful and that the Office of Public Information has been helpful to the delegates. The purpose of the resolution which has been presented to you, Resolution No. 26, are three-fold.

First, the most important function is to carry out the mandate of the legislature to inform the public of the content of the new Constitution.

Secondly, we must wind up the affairs of the Convention in an orderly and businesslike manner. We cannot adjourn sine die and walk out and leave things as we are. I am not certain that the legislature would approve of this also.
