DELEGATE SCANLAN: Although your approval of Resolution 26 takes care of one of the most important Convention activities, I think in order to be absolutely sure of the authority of the President to expend funds on behalf of the Convention in winding up the postconvention activities, that Resolution No. 27 really is necessary. The resolution has been shown to and has been approved by the Attorney General and would make it perfectly clear that the President had the authority to enter into contracts, including employment contracts, in connection with the winding up of the post=convention activities and while it is possible to interpret Resolution No. 26 to go this far, in order to be perfectly clear and since it has the approval of the Attorney General, and I think it would mean that any expenditures entered into and approved by the President in the post-convention period would be approved by the Comptroller, and I think it would be wise that you adopt it and I move that vou do.
