

1 THE PRESIDENT: Any other questions?

2 The Chair hears none.

3 We will proceed to a consideration of Article 2.
4 DELEGATE PENNIMAN:

5 We were working with the staff and the Chairman
6 of the Committee on Suffrage and Elections. The first
7 change is the one that is to be found in lines 26, 7, 8,
8 and 9, which was merely reworking and trying to make somewhat
9 more obvious with the assistance of all of us who were there
10 from the Substantive Commission and the Committee on Style
11 the decision of this Convention which was made as I remember
12 it on Wednesday in making an amendment to this section on
13 voters in the national, state, and county election.

14 Sections 2.02 and 2.03 have been switched around
15 because it seems obvious we should follow voters in
16 national, state, and county elections, and those who have
17 voted in presidential elections and to put voters in
18 municipal elections separately.

19 In the new 2.03, the one on voters in municipal
20 elections in line 9 "nor" was changed as it should have
21 been to "or".

22 In Section 6 we added the words "by law". That
