DELEGATE PENNIMAN: It is difficult to see 1 italics when they are in quotation marks, but it is true 2 that there are quotation marks around "to be enacted by 3 the General Assembly of Maryland". 4 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Borom. 5 DELEGATE BOROM: Mr. Chairman, on pages 10 and 6 11, I call your attention to Section 3.06, line 34, and the 7 use of the term "shall transmit it", and we went through 8 this on second reading and we went through Section 3.08, 9 line 26. You are using the same reading. I made the 10 suggestion to Style that we should change the words "the 11 plan" to it. 12 That is correct.
