serve until a person has qualified to become governor or to 1 2 serve as acting governor." That will take care of it in each of the 3 circumstances where it comes up under Executive Branch. On page 13, we have added the subheading "Guber-5 natorial Succession". Then there have been no changes in 6 4.06, 4.07, 4.08, until we come to the problem on line 14. 7 We had a problem here of explaining in the same 8 manner as described above so as to take care of for the 9 Governor elect and the Lieutenant Governor elect the same 10 manner of looking into their disability as for the Governor 11 or for the Lieutenant Governor and we used this to refer 12 back in a less ambiguous manner than we had done it last 13 time to the procedure already described. 14 Apparently you also struck the THE PRESIDENT: 15 comma at the end of line 1. 16 Yes, that is correct.
