7 DELEGATE WEIDEMEYER: I withdraw my objection.

8 THE PRESIDENT: Thank you.

9 Any objection to changing the word "provided"
10 to "prescribed", line 44, page 8?

11 The Chair hears none. The change will be made.

12 Delegate Mentzer.

13 DELEGATE MENTZER: While I am doing so well,
14 Mr. President, I would like to call attention to page 49,
15 Incorporation Charters, and on line 16, there is a comma
16 after the word "provided". It seems completely unnecessary.

17 THE PRESIDENT: Where?

18 DELEGATE MENTZER: Page 49, line 16, after the
19 word "provided" at the end of the line.

20 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Penniman, do you agree?

21 DELEGATE PENNIMAN: I think it can be removed.
