

1 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I don't so read it, no.

2 THE PRESIDENT: I think the point is well taken,
3 Delegate Gallagher. Would not the sentence properly read,
4 "boundaries of districts shall be redrawn in 1982 and in
5 every tenth year thereafter, according to these standards"?

6 That wouldn't do it either.

7 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Yes. If you move the
8 entire line up, line 10, I think it would preserve more
9 accurately the intention of redistricting or redrawing every
10 ten years.

11 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate James.

12 DELEGATE JAMES: Mr. Chairman, I object. I
13 have lost the thread of the discussion.

14 THE PRESIDENT: May I make one more suggestion,
15 Delegate James?

16 Delegate Gallagher, would it be better if all
17 of line 10 were added before the word "boundaries" in line
18 7? Would it then carry out your intent?

19 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: It would, Mr. President.
20 Starting with "in 1982 and every tenth year thereafter
21 boundaries of districts shall be redrawn according to these
