

1 had authority to call upon various committee chairmen
2 to give a little status report whenever that was appro-
3 priate, whether we needed a rule for that. The Committee
4 was of the opinion that no such rule was necessary.

5 So at the end, I return to the beginning, which
6 was our proposed amendment to Rule 5. You will recall what?
7 Let me put it this way: The original proposal was that both
8 the Chairman and the Vice-chairman of the Committees of this
9 Convention would be selected by the President, but in the
10 meeting of the Temporary Rules Committee a few days
11 before our organizing session in July, on motion, I be-
12 lieve of Delegate Gallagher, it was approved, recommended
13 and approved that vice-chairmen be elected. During the
14 debate on the adoption of the rules in our organizing ses-
15 sion in July, I believe Delegate Grumbacher offered an
16 amendment which would have made the vice-chairmen sub-
17 ject to the same procedure as the chairman. Both would
18 be appointed. That motion was defeated. In the interval
19 Senator Malkus sponsored an amendment which would go
20 back to the original amendment, the original proposal
21 and have vice-chairmen appointed by the President. There
