10 A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the amendment;  
11 a vote No is a vote against.

13 Has every delegate voted?

14 Does any delegate desire to change his vote?

15 The Clerk will record the vote.

16 There being fifty-nine votes in the affirmative  
17 and fifty-seven in the negative, the motion is carried.  
18 The amendment is adopted.
