2 On the motion to reconsider, the same vote will
3 be required so that the seventy-two votes is required on
4 each motion.

5 Are you ready for the question?

6 The question arises, first, on the motion to
7 suspend all interfering rules so as to permit immediate
8 consideration of the motion to reconsider the vote by which
9 Section 6.17 failed of adoption.

10 A vote Aye is a vote to suspend the rules, a
11 vote No is a vote against.

12 Cast your vote.

13 The Clerk will record the vote.

14 There being eighty-nine votes in the affirmative
15 and thirty-three in the negative, the interfering rules
16 are suspended.
