3 DELEGATE MARVIN SMITH: Point of order. The
4 motion before us is a motion to order the previous question.

5 THE PRESIDENT: Thank you very much. The question
6 before us is a motion to order the previous question. All
7 in favor signify by saying Aye; opposed, No.

8 The Ayes have it and it is so ordered.

9 The question arises on the motion that 6.17 was
10 not adopted. The motion is to reconsider. If the motion
11 carries, then 6.17 will be before you. If it fails, then
12 it will not be before you. A vote Aye is a vote in favor
13 of reconsideration; a vote No is a vote against. Cast your
14 vote.

15 (Whereupon, a rollcall vote was taken.)

16 THE PRESIDENT: Has every delegate voted?

17 Does any delegate desire to change his vote?

18 The Clerk will record the vote.

19 There being 80 votes in the affirmative and 40
20 in the negative, the motion is carried and the vote by
