2 and then amendments offered from the floor, amendments  
3 which when read against the marked up copy, the blue copy,  
4 seemed perfectly all right, but they pop out at you when you  
5 see the clean copy without any disturbing interference by  
6 strikeouts or italicized language.

7           These will be offered to you. None needs more  
8 than half a minute of explanation, and we can offer them.  
9 Nonetheless, we have to go through a certain procedure  
10 in order to do this and, at the proper time, after the  
11 amendments are all completed and printed, Delegate Powers  
12 will move to suspend interfering rules to reconsider the  
13 vote by which the entire Constitution was passed, in order  
14 to reconsider the vote by which certain articles were  
15 passed, in order to consider specific amendments.

16           After the amendments have been acted upon, we  
17 readopt the articles that have been opened up and readopt  
18 the entire Constitution. This will afford the opportunity  
19 to some of the delegates who were unable to be here Satur-  
20 day and who have asked the Chair if there isn't some  
21 way in which they can express their approbation of the
