

1 Mr. Clerk, are there any reports?

2 MR. QUILLEN: There are no reports, Mr. President.

3 THE PRESIDENT: The Committee Report LB-1 was  
4 read across the desk several days ago. It is on the  
5 agenda today. I think it requires a brief explanation.

6 The Chair recognizes Delegate Gallagher.

7 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Mr. President and ladies  
8 and gentlemen: I think it may be necessary for me to  
9 move to suspend all interfering rules so that Committee  
10 Report LB-1 may be received and considered?

11 THE PRESIDENT: No. It may be considered  
12 without suspension of the rules.

13 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: In that event, briefly,  
14 Mr. President and ladies and gentlemen:

15 This is a Report of Consideration and Disposi-  
16 tion which the Committee on the Legislative Branch gave  
17 to those proposals which were not in some manner incorporated  
18 in LB-1, LB-2, or LB-3. It is self-explanatory.
