4 WHEREAS, this mace has been placed upon the ros-
5 trum beside the President throughout the Convention for
6 the purpose of showing when the Convention was officially
7 in session, and has served to remind the Convention of the
8 trust reposed in it by the people of Maryland, and source
9 of the responsibility given it.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the
11 Constitutional Convention of Maryland expresses its appre-
12 ciation to Samuel Kirk and Son, Incorporated, for manu-
13 facturing and presenting to the Convention the mace used
14 as the symbol of the sovereignty of the people of the State
15 of Maryland, and be it further

16 RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be
17 forwarded to Howard T. Brenner, President of Samuel Kirk
18 and Son, Incorporated.
