

1 in line 5 you should also add one after the word
2 "legislation" in line 6.

3 THE PRESIDENT: No, the reason for the comma in
4 line 5 after "provisions" is that the Committee on Style has
5 followed the rule that there is to be a comma after each
6 part of the series but not at the end of the entire series.
7 You wouldn't separate the series from the verb. Is that
8 right, Delegate Penniman?

9 The comma is not intended to make the other ex-
10 pression parenthetical.

11 The question arises on the adoption of Amendment
12 25. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the amendment. A vote
13 No is a vote against.

14 Cast your vote.

15 (Whereupon, a rollcall vote was taken.)

16 THE PRESIDENT: Has every delegate voted? Does
17 any delegate desire to change his vote?

18 The Clerk will record the vote.

19 There being 103 votes in the affirmative and none
20 in the negative, the motion is carried and the amendment is
21 adopted.
