

1 The purpose is obvious, to change a comma to a
2 semi-colon.

3 Are you ready for the question?

4 A vote Aye is a vote in favor of Amendment 27.
5 A vote No is a vote against.

6 Cast your vote.

7 (Whereupon, a rollcall vote was taken.)

8 THE PRESIDENT: Has every delegate voted? Does
9 any delegate desire to change his vote?

10 The Clerk will record the vote.

11 There being 99 votes in the affirmative and 4 in
12 the negative, the motion is carried and the amendment is
13 adopted.

14 The next amendment is AH. It is Amendment 28.
15 Amendment 28 is AH.

16 The Clerk will read the amendment.

17 The amendment appears on line 3 of
18 page 62 of the white copy.
