2 and you couldn't enter a hotel or motel or restaurant;
3 and it is just historical that the Constitution is being
4 written during this time when it is possible for the
5 world to see that democracy does work and can work. And
6 when each delegate goes back to his home, I hope he will
7 remember this as a prime example that we can get
8 along together; that nobody -- I don't think any American
9 citizen wants anything but first-class citizenship, and
10 just to be treated as an ordinary person, and I think
11 that was done here. (Applause.)
