would act would provide by law that this would require
a constitutional majority of both Houses first to pass the
law, which would have to be signed, of course, by
the Governor, when it says appointed by the General
Assembly, this would require a majority of each House of
the General Assembly.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? The question arises on the motion to substitute for Committee Recommendation SF-1 the provision "the General Assembly shall provide by law for post-audit of state finances by an agency of the General Assembly directed by a person appointed by it and under its control".

Parliamentarian suggests that I call to your attention that if anyone desires to offer amendments to the substitute, now is the appropriate time to offer such amendments and not after the substitute shall have been voted upon.

Is there any further discussion of the motion to substitute or any amendments to be offered to the substitute? Are you ready for the question? A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the substitution, a vote No, a vote
