alphabetical order to sign, the Chairman will call the 1 oldest delegate and then the youngest delegate, and after 2 that we will call each delegate in alphabetical order. Each delegate will sign with a pen which he will then keep as a personal souvenir. Delegate Winslow. (The delegates arose and applauded.) (The Honorable Clinton I. Winslow, Delegate 8 from the Third District, Baltimore County, seated at the historic desk from the Old Senate Chamber, affixed his 10 signature to the draft Constitution.) 11 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Hutchinson. 12 (Applause) (The Honorable Donald P. Hutchinson, Delegate 13 from the Fifth District, Baltimore County, seated at the 14 historic desk from the Old Senate Chamber, affixed his 15 signature to the draft Constitution.) 16 THE PRESIDENT: There are two delegates who 17 have remained here because of their great anxiety to be 18 permitted to sign the Constitution. It is imperative that 19 they leave because of serious illnesses in their families. 20 The Chair will have them sign first. 21
