Storm, Delegate from Frederick County, seated at the historic desk from the 3 Old Senate Chamber, affixed his signature to the draft Constitution.) THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Malkus. (Applause) (The Honorable Frederick C. Malkus, Jr., Delegate from Dorchester County, seated at the historic 8 desk from the Old Senate Chamber, affixed his signature to the draft Constitution.) 10 11 THE PRESIDENT: The reading clerk will now call the remaining delegates in alphabetical order. 12 Consideration was given to calling the names in 13 reverse alphabetical order, but it was abandoned because 14 the quality of the paper on which the Constitution is printed 15 is such that although it has been drying for some hours, 16 it is not thoroughly dry, and we are afraid of smearing. 17 The delegates will please, as they leave their 18 chairs, go to the back of the chamber so you can walk forward 19 as your name is called. 20
