1 chairman of one of the committees of this Convention. 2 I think it only proper that at this point that 3 I say very clearly that without the help, the assistance, and the cooperation of the members of my committee and, in addition, the understanding and the help of the members of this Convention, that whatever honor I was able to bring to that job I did bring. 8 Thirdly, I would like on a much more personal note to bring to your attention the fact that I could 10 not have come here at all without my younger daughter 11 assuming much more responsibility than any seventeen-year 12 old should be asked to do, and I convinced her finally to 13 come today and to join me in this, a very significant day. 14 I hope you will welcome my daughter, Tammy, 15 who is in the balcony over the rostrum. (Applause) 16 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Koger. DELEGATE KOGER: Mr. Chairman and ladies and 17 18 gentlemen: I hope that you will welcome my wife, Dorothy, 19 20 who is here today. (Applause)
