

1 DELEGATE CHURCHILL MURRAY: Mr. President,
2 in spite of the blanket clause that covered everyone, I
3 would like to ask the Convention to join me in recognizing
4 the Librarian of the Convention, Mrs. Keller. Mrs.
5 Keller's work has contributed so much to the progress of
6 the Convention.

7 I might also add that she was one of the
8 people who contributed to my election, I having sought
9 election without any political support, other than the
10 opposition. (Applause)

12 DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: Mr. President, it is
13 my pleasure to introduce to the Convention the wife of
14 my righthand man here, Mrs. William Rush. (Applause)

15 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Bothe.

16 DELEGATE BOTHE: Mr. President, my husband is
17 not present in the balcony today, although he has been on
18 many previous occasions.

20 the Constitutional Convention Commission swung into
21 operation, and he has sometimes doubted who I married.
