1 DELEGATE CHURCHILL MURRAY: Mr. President, 2 in spite of the blanket clause that covered everyone, I 3 would like to ask the Convention to join me in recognizing the Librarian of the Convention, Mrs. Keller. Mrs. Keller's work has contributed so much to the progress of the Convention. 7 I might also add that she was one of the 8 people who contributed to my election, I having sought 9 election without any political support, other than the 10 (Applause) opposition. 11 Delegate Rybczynski. THE PRESIDENT: DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: Mr. President, it is 12 my pleasure to introduce to the Convention the wife of 13 my righthand man here, Mrs. William Rush. (Applause) 14 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Bothe. 15 DELEGATE BOTHE: Mr. President, my husband is 16 not present in the balcony today, although he has been on 17 many previous occasions. 18 We were married approximately two weeks after 19 the Constitutional Convention Commission swung into 20 operation, and he has sometimes doubted who I married. 21
