THE CHAIRMAN: The Committee of the Whole will now come to order. It will have for consideration the Committee Recommendation No. GP-2, filed on November 2, 1967. The Chair recognizes Delegate Boyer, Chairman of the Committee on General Provisions, and requests he come forward to the Reading Clerk's desk.
