your Committee concluded that an oath does have a proper place in our Constitution.

We felt that freedom was fragile, and it should be handled with prayer. Your Committee recommends the resolution for favorable consideration.

THE CHAIRMAN: Are there any questions for purposes of clarification?

Delegate Sickles?

DELEGATE SICKLES: I wonder if the Chairman of the Committee would explain to the Committee who would be covered, when it says, "every person elected or appointed to any office of profit or trust", under the Constitution or laws of this State specifically; specifically, I am concerned as to whether this oath would be applied to office-holders on the municipal level, county level, bi-county agency level.

DELEGATE BOYER: Delegate Sickles, I don't think that the General Provisions Committee really came to any concrete conclusion in answer to your question. It would be my thought, humbly, that this would apply to any office, elected official, for an office of profit or trust or appointed official for such, on a Statewide level. I
