Now, if it is the Committee's opinion that a non-believer would be eligible to office under this phrase. as you have drawn it, I suggest that should be stated in the comment at least. I don't find anywhere a clear statement to that effect, because it may be of the utmost importance when this case, as undoubtedly will come before the court and particularly the Supreme Court for interpretation.

THE CHAIRMAN: So that the transcript may be clear on this point, I would like to ask Delegate Boyer as Chairman of the Committee to state unequivocably if he can whether the opinion of the Committee was, as Judge Henderson just indicate, namely, that the oath could be taken, the oath or affirmation, could be taken by the person who did not believe in a Supreme Being, and that belief in a Supreme Being was therefore not under this section at least a qualification for office.

DELEGATE BOYER: There are no discriminations in the section as we present it that would allow special privileges to any particular class, and it would have to be
