2 Committee on Rules will be here for the next 90, perhaps
3 120 days. It is not a matter that we have to reach today,
4 since it will be a tailend matter. Obviously, I would
5 think in that case, an affirmative vote of the majority
6 of delegates would entertain a report from the Committee
7 on General Provisions dealing with the schedule, but I
8 agree with you, let's make it clear; but I think we can do
9 that with careful language as a further amendment to
10 Rule 28(a). I agree with you, the intent of this rule
11 as it now stands is not to preclude a belated report
12 from the Committee on General Provisions dealing with the
13 schedule. Does this answer your question?

14 DELEGATE CHABOT: Yes, sir, and as to Rule 37,
15 would the Chairman explain the reason why a limitation,
16 a motion to make a limitation under that rule must be made
17 before a proposal is taken up?

18 DELEGATE SCANLAN: Well, in order to have some
19 order in the proceeding, these proposals in the Committee
20 of the Whole will be on the general order agenda, I believe
21 it is called, either general or special orders; so there
